Council Agenda Preview

Next Council meeting is March 27th with a special meeting at 6 p.m. with an update on the water rate study. This portion of the meeting will update the Council and public on the water financial plan overview providing a preliminary model overview highlighting inflation assumptions,

proposed and projected O & M (operations & maintenance), projected growth in accounts/usage, the capital improvement program (CIP), financial policies, and financial plan scenarios.

The regular meeting will includes items on:

- Water heater for competition pool
- Agreement with Routematch Software for computer & electronic upgrades for the Readi-Ride transit system
- Approve street closure of State Highway 113 for the Annual Dixon May Fair Parade
- Agreement with City of Suisun for administrative citations issued by the Police Department processing
- Ordinance to exempt government facilities from certain setback requirements and screening height limitations
- The 2017 General Plan annual progress report
- Budget amendment for water facility improvements and maintenance and authorize an interfund loan from the General Fund Contingency Fund to facilitate the improvements.

Phone Spoofing – It's Out There

Spoofing is happening with the caller ID showing the City of Dixon as the caller possibly trying to sell something, we have heard medical devices was one scam. Spoofing, according the FCC, is an attempt to get valuable personal info that could be used for fraudulent activity. DO NOT give

out personal info such as account numbers, mothers maiden names.

You can report spoofing to the FCC if you suspect the caller ID has been falsified. There is a form online to report such activity that you can navigate to from the FCC website www.fcc.gov.

- Industrial Well & Hydro Tank Improvements (\$2.5 million)
- School Well Replacement (\$3.9 million)
- Fitzgerald & Parklane tank Cleaning (\$795k)
- Watson Ranch Service Replacement (\$550k)
